



## Medicaid Services

- Medicaid
  - Provides health care services to eligible elderly and disabled individuals and eligible low-income pregnant women, children and parents.
  - Aged, Blind and Disabled:
    - Age 65 or older
    - Age 64 or younger AND Blind or Disabled
  - Share of Cost (Medically Needy)
    - For eligible individuals with a medical need but whose income exceeds Medicaid income limits
  - Medicare Part B Buy In
    - Provides payment of Medicare Premium for eligible individuals
      - SLMB - Specified Low Income Medicare Beneficiaries – Individual may be eligible for payment of their Medicare Premium AND Share of Cost
      - QI-1 - Qualified Individuals – May choose between having Medicare Premium paid OR Share of Cost
  - Women's Cancer Program
    - Provides health care services to women ages 40-65 who have been diagnosed with breast or cervical cancer.
  - Personal Assistance Services (PAS)
    - Provides assistance with payment for help with activities of daily living: Bathing, Dressing, Meal Preparation, Laundry, Cleaning, Assistance with Toileting/Diapering, Transfers/Assistance with walking/wheelchairs
    - Individual must be eligible for and receiving Medicaid, Living at home, and have an assessed need for the service in order to continue to live in the community.
  - Children's Medicaid
    - Provides health care services to eligible children from birth through age 18.

- **Former Foster Care**
  - Provides health care services for individuals who were previously in foster care in the state of Nebraska until their 19<sup>th</sup> birthday in addition to being Medicaid eligible. Eligible participants will receive Medicaid coverage under this program from age 19-26 as long as they remain Nebraska residents.
- **Parents/Caretaker Relatives Medicaid**
  - Provides health care services to parents who meet an eligibility requirement: Absence of Parent, Death of Parent, Incapacity/Disability, or Under/Unemployment
- **Pregnant Women**
  - Provides health care services to eligible pregnant women to cover pregnancy related medical and 60 days post-partum coverage.
